Topics to be covered throughout the day include:

- Control of bleeding
- Maintaining airways
- Performing CPR
- Recognising vital signs - RR, HR, MM, CRT, etc
- Signs of shock
- Handling distressed animals
- Fight wounds
- Accidental ingestion of drugs, alcohol, etc
- Heat stress
- Various chemical poisonings
- Tick poisonings
- Snake bites
- Cane toad poisoning (QLD only)
- Trauma/ Hit by a car
- Hypothermia
- Various "do's" & "don'ts"
